

Chestnut-sided Warbler

Chestnut-sided warblers stop briefly at Quarry Gardens in spring and fall as they fly between their breeding grounds high in the Appalachian Mountains and their wintering grounds in Central America. Like most migrants, chestnut-sided warblers don't just breed or winter anywhere within their range. If they can, they will almost always spend their time in the exact same place they used during previous seasons.
